### **Prerequisites**

- **>** Quebec Secondary V or equivalent Highschool
- > English language requirements (NON SDS application route): lelts 5.0 (nothing less than 5.0 in any individual module) or equivalent accepted test (Duolingo, Matrix, Language Canada accredited members, TOEFL etc...)
- **)** Exemption: Students having a High School Diploma from native English speaking countries (example: Nigeria, Philippines)
- > French language requirements: A0 to B2.2 French program is mandatory for those students who wish to pursue ASC in English;
- > Exemptions from French program registration: Students are exempt from Matrix College's French language program, if they produce a proof of B2 level third party test / Matrix's online placement test or have a High School Diploma in French from French speaking countries or have a B2 level certificate from Languages Canada accredited members.
